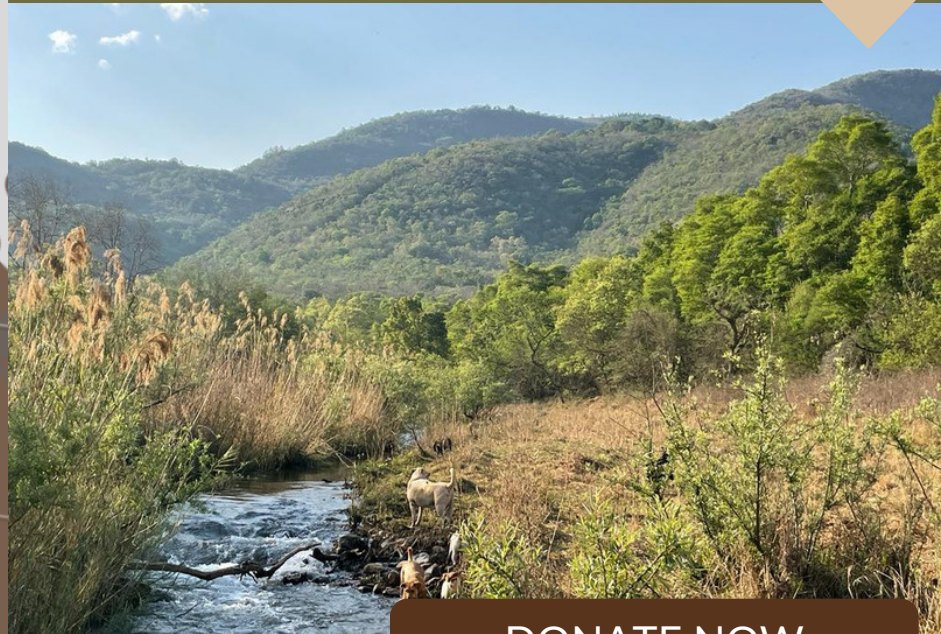
You will receive a 'supporters certificate' and be allocated a unique 3x3m square in the project target area.
